

Streetscape Masterplan Goals

Develop a plan for the public right of way that addresses:

- Infrastructure improvement needs
- The safety and convenience of all users of the transportation system
- The pedestrian experience and sense of place
- Connectivity throughout the corridor
- Transit needs
- Sustainable best practices
- Long term maintenance



Benefits of a Streetscape Masterplan

A streetscape masterplan is a prioritized and phased implementation document that outlines the proposed right of way improvements, including cost estimates, and potential funding sources.

How does the plan get implemented?

- Federal, state, or city funding
- Leveraging public and private utility upgrades
- Leveraging private development

- Understand how the community uses the project corridor
- Discuss the possibilities for the project corridor

61st Street Streetscape Master Plan Project Limits





April 2, 2018 Meeting Results

Discussion area: Cottage Grove Ave. to Blackstone Ave.

- Use infrastructure elements to create a more cohesive and symmetrical street
 - Widen the sidewalk on the south side of the street.
 - Increase the roadway and pedestrian lighting on 61st street.
 - Improve drainage system along 61st street.
 - Add more greenery to make the south side of 61st street appear more welcoming
- Develop a community identity
 - Blend the lines between the north and south sides of 61st street.
 - Thoughtfully build long-lasting Woodlawn community identifiers.
- Improve pedestrian accessibility
 - Incorporate bump outs to slow traffic and increase pedestrian safety.
 - Increase the number of and visibility of crosswalks.
 - Safety concern that traffic moves too fast down 61st Street.
- Bicycle Accommodations
 - Mixed reviews on adding bike lanes.
- Transit Accommodations
 - Mixed reviews on expanding/ modifying bus stop and shelter infrastructure (for both CTA busses and University of Chicago shuttles).




Streetscape Tools

- New sidewalks & ADA ramps
- Improve drainage: curb and gutter reconstruction, catch basin replacement
- Street resurfacing
- New lighting
- Unique community light pole and sidewalk identifiers
- Landscape Improvements: Trees and tree grates, planters, hanging baskets
- Stamped and textured crosswalks
- Streetscape furniture: benches, trash receptacles, bike racks
- Bump-outs and seating areas on side streets
- Bike lanes



61st St cross section and plan view


