

## PROJECT AREA AND PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS



- Roadway geometry and intersection improvement
- Full width resurfacing
- Drainage improvements
- Sidewalk, curb, and gutter
- Curb extensions ADA ramps and crosswalks
- Street lighting
- Traffic signal upgrades

- Improved signage
- Side street improvements to the alleys as needed
- Bike lanes
- Site furniture and potential seating areas
- Light pole identifiers
- Tree planting and potential landscaping
- Potential plaza at the cul-de-sac on 92nd, west of South Harbor




### LIGHTPOLE IDENTIFIER














### LIGHT POLE IDENTIFIER AND SIDEWALK PLAQUES

#### **Light Pole Identifiers**




#### Inspiration


