## Roadway Improvements

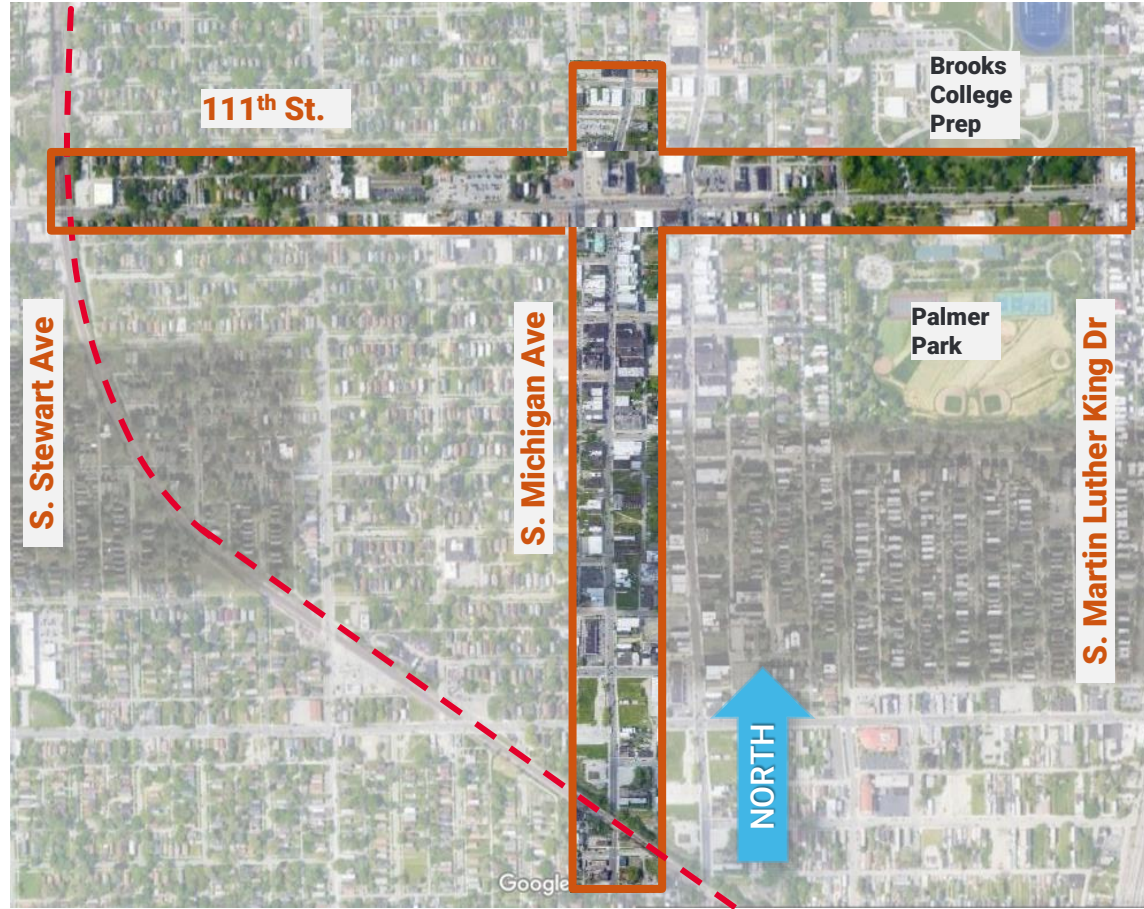
- Roadway geometry and intersection improvements
- Full width resurfacing
- Drainage improvements
- Sidewalk, curb, and gutter
- Traffic signal upgrades
- Side street improvements to the alleys as needed

## Pedestrian Area Improvements

- ADA ramps and crosswalks
- Street lighting
- Improved pavement markings and signage
- Site furniture and potential seating areas
- Tree planting and potential landscaping

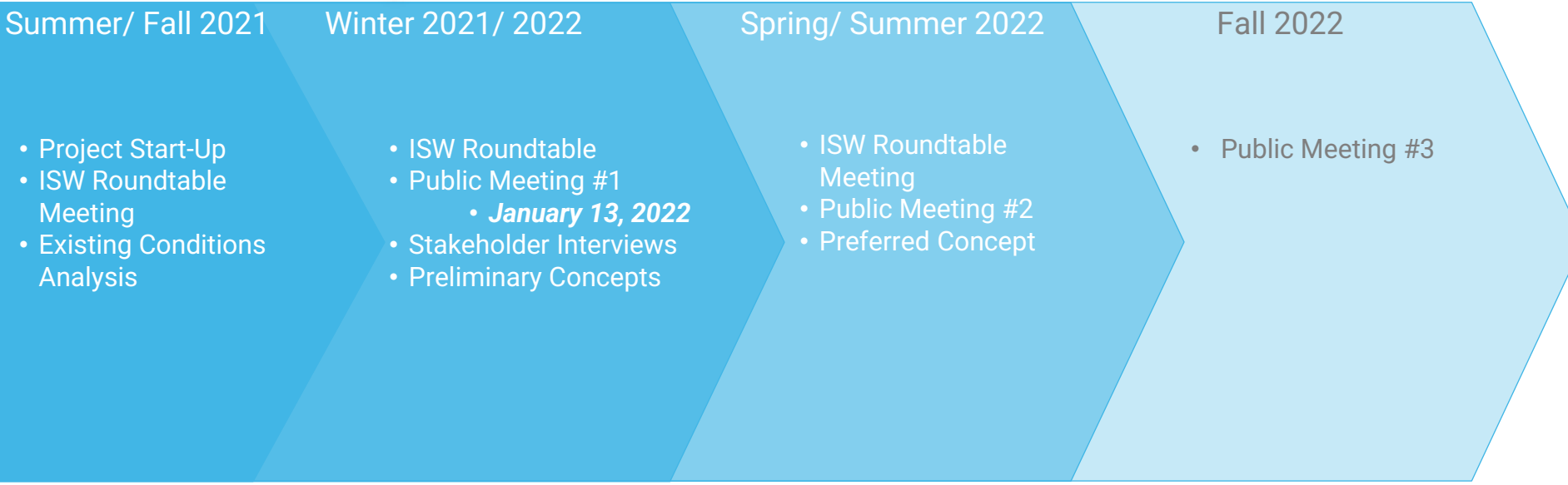

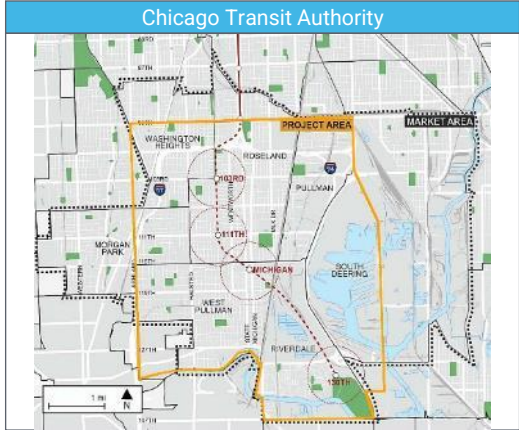
### Michigan Avenue Streetscape Masterplan

Completed by CDOT in 2013, the masterplan identified needed infrastructure upgrades as well as the potential for 2 plaza spaces.



### Roseland Medical District

Led by DPD, the study focuses on the area surrounding the Roseland Medical District. The study is currently underway.



### Transit Supported Development Plan

As part of the Red Line Extension, the CTA is leading a Transit-Supportive Development (TSD) Plan. The plan aims to create a guide for future development in communities located near the RLE project area.

# WHAT YOU SAID



### PUBLIC COMMENT SUMMARY

Written and verbal public comments during the kick-off event reflected a wide range of views about the economic health of Michigan Avenue and 111th Street and their roles within Greater Roseland. Public feedback was reviewed by planning staff and distilled into main categories that include primary needs and goals, as well as concerns and issues. Summary statements are listed below. These priorities will guide community-based policies and decision-making as improvements are strategized and financed in the months ahead.



### BUDGET GOALS

To help determine spending priorities for public realm improvements, planning participants were asked to select up to three types of enhancements from 11 types of examples, such as reusing right-of-ways typically used for cars as spaces for people, hosting events in parks and other public facilities, and making streets and other thoroughfares safer to cross. #### Primary Needs and Goals

- Rehabilitation of historic buildings
- Additional retail options
- More pedestrian and bike connectivity with parks and employment centers
- Maintenance and amenities to enhance the pedestrian experience
- More public art

#### Main Concerns

- Need to leave community for expanded retail options
- More public transit amenities
- Condition of Metra facilities
- Lack of job opportunities

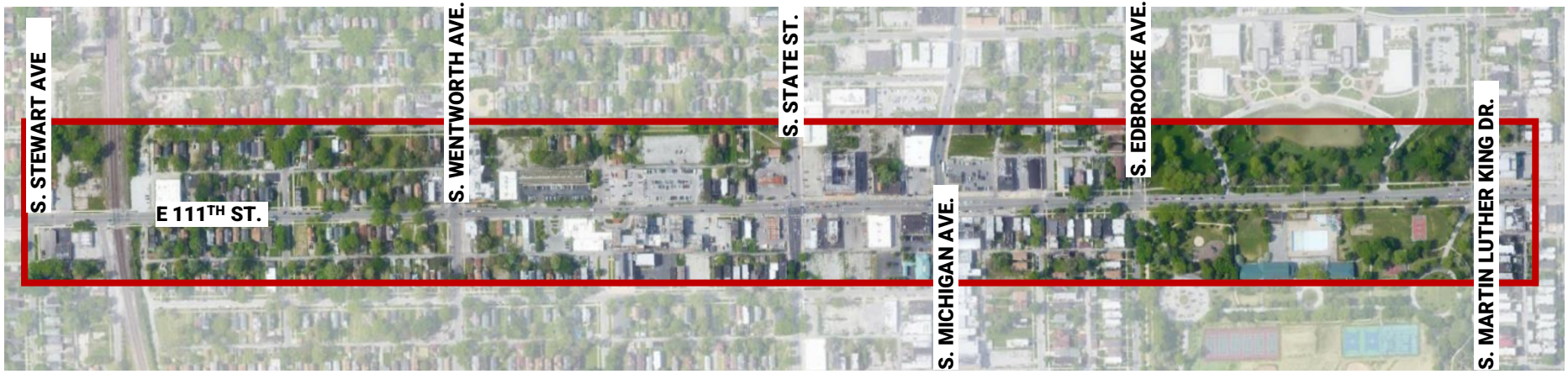




Typical Section

S. Michigan Avenue





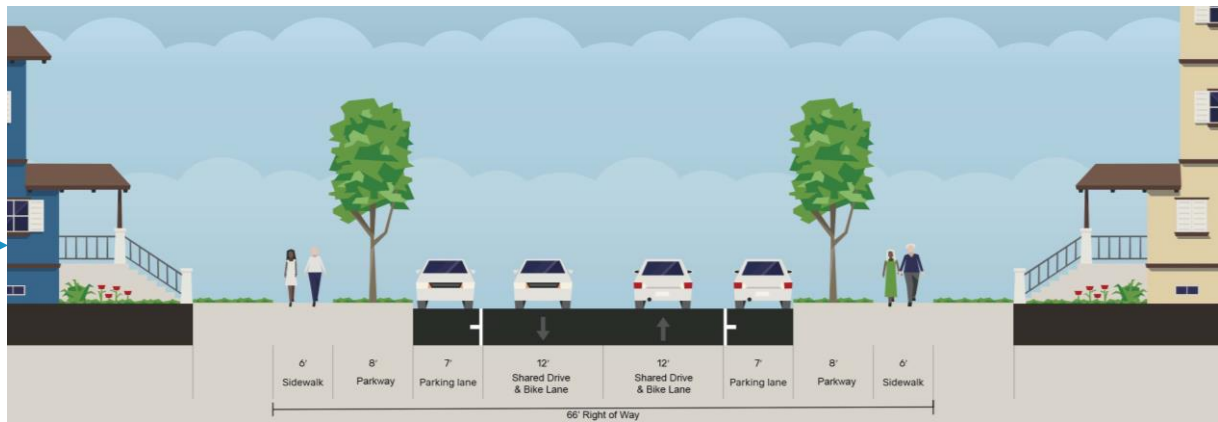

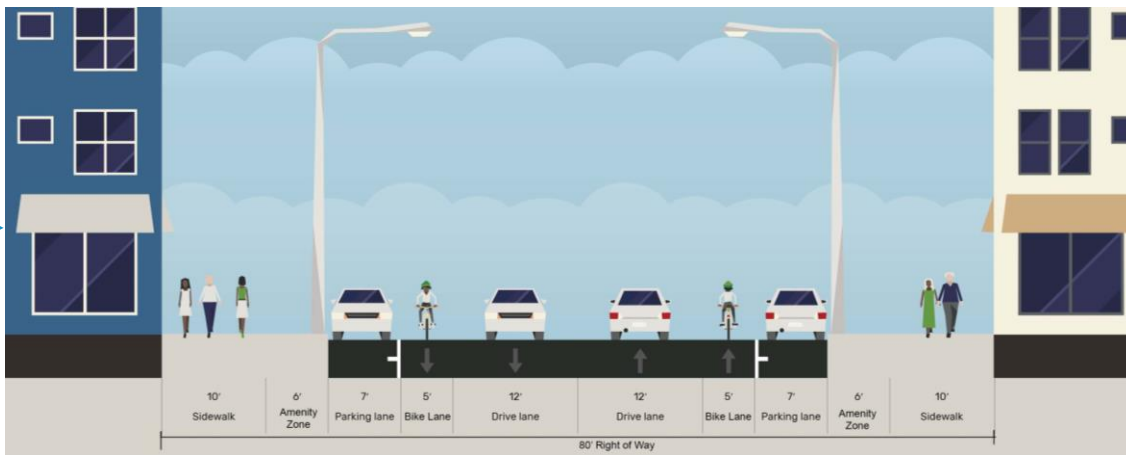
Typical Section


